- Font- Times New Roman, 12, A4 size with a standard margin of 1 inch on all sides.
- The Authors name, designation and affiliation should be typed after the title and should include email.
- Graphs, figures, photos and tables should be placed in the text wherever they are discussed.
- For reference APA format 6th edition to be adopted
- Plagiarism of any type to be strictly avoided
- The last date for submission of articles –**6th February 2026**
- The contributors will be informed about the acceptance after the review process
